Pinot Noir Bühlertal „Alte Reben“ (old vines)

2017 – dry

VINEYARD

The vineyards are situated in the village of Bühlertal, which is very well known for its red wines. The terroir consists of lighter residual granite soil with a steep south/south-west slopes.

YIELD

41 hl/ha; Sugar content at harvest 91 °Oe.

ANALYSES

Alcohol 13,0 % by vol.; Residual sugar 0,5 g/l; Total Acidity 5,6 g/l.

WINEMAKING

Selectively hand-picked grapes were gently destemmed. A traditional fermentation on the skins was conducted for 30 days followed by malolactic fermentation and maturation of the wine for 16-monthes in oak barrels.

EXPERIENCE

Powerful, concentrated Pinot Noir from old vines. Impressive palate with spicy and berry-like notes and a long and dry finish.

PAIRS WELL WITH

stewed dishes with hand-grated spaetzle or beef fillet.

16 - 18 °C
